Guidelines for GCP Theatre Arts Scholarships
& GCP/Gaylord Rotary Club Steve Glidden Memorial Scholarship.

The purpose of the GCP and the Gaylord Rotary Theatre Arts Scholarships is to promote talent, love and enjoyment of the experience of “live” theatre through further education and learning in both the artistic and technical fields of theatre arts.

**Scholarships may be used for classes, lessons, or supplies in the following area of study:
(Individual applicants only...Groups may not apply.)**

1. Acting, singing, dancing, choreography, music.
2. Lighting or sound technology.
3. Make-up, scenery construction, set decoration, costume design and construction.
4. Theater management or theatre marketing.
5. Directing or producing.
6. Script or play writing.

One Rotary scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$500.00. GCP will match up to \$1500.00 additional (or less). Scholarships must be used in the year awarded and be completed by September 14 of the following year.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Applicant must be an Otsego County resident OR attend an Otsego County School (If applicant is a student).
2. Applicant must be age 12 or older.
3. Applicant must fill out an application thoroughly.
4. Applicant must submit **TWO** letters of recommendation.
5. Applicant must write a one-page, double spaced **ESSAY** explaining how the money would be used, and why the applicant should receive the scholarship.

Completed applications, letters and essays are due each year by May 15th.
Award presentation is completed by June 6th of the grant year.
